# Part 2: Responsibilities for health and safety

Overall and final responsibility for health and safety rests with the Board of Directors

To ensure health and safety standards are maintained/improved, the following people have responsibility in the following areas:

Graham Walker – safety of visitors and volunteers on nature reserves and when undertaking surveys, risk assessments, consulting volunteers

Event Organiser – safety of members and non-members attending events

Meeting Leader - safety of members and non-members attending field meetings

All volunteers and those attending events and field meetings should:

- Co-operate on health and safety matters;
- Take reasonable care of their own health and safety; and
- Report all health and safety concerns to an appropriate person (as detailed above)

# Part 3: Arrangements for health and safety

#### Risk assessment

- We will complete relevant risk assessments and take necessary action
- We will review risk assessments when working habits or conditions change

## **Training**

- We will give volunteers health and safety induction and provide appropriate training
- We will ensure individuals/volunteers are equipped with appropriate personal protective equipment
- We will ensure suitable arrangements are in place for volunteers working remotely

### Consultation

We will consult volunteers routinely on health a safety matters as they arise and formally when we review health and safety

### Other

- We will ensure contractors have the necessary training and are aware of on-site risks
- We will ensure that we aware of health and safety procedures that are in place at venues we use, including evacuation procedures, and impart them as appropriate to all participants.
